Mayor John G. Testa and the Peekskill City Council announce the establishment of a City Code Enforcement Hot Line.

The Hot Line is intended to provide residents with a convenient way to report possible safety violations, quality of life concerns or simple information such as the location of a pothole or burned out streetlight.

When residents call the Hot Line at 914-862-2065 they will be greeted with a recorded message from the Mayor welcoming their input via voice mail. The information can be left anonymously or, if a follow-up is requested, the caller can leave a means of contact.

"We are serious about improving the quality of life in Peekskill and we invite our residents to become part of the process," stated Mayor Testa, "By giving residents a simple and hassle free way of providing information, our staff can address problems that they might not have otherwise been aware of."

The City Council will periodically be provided with a compilation of the calls so that they may monitor the information and follow up with staff members.
