CITY OF PEEKSKILL HONORS 18 RECIPIENTS AT THE 2002 HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARDS CEREMONY

(Peekskill, New York)... Mayor John G. Testa and the Common Council are pleased to announce that on Sunday, October 6, 2002 at 3:00 pm, the 2002 Peekskill Historic Preservation Awards Ceremony will take place at the Peekskill Museum located at 124 Union Avenue.

The Peekskill Historic Preservation Awards began in 1990 as ceremony to recognize and honor property owners who have either restored or preserved the wealth of historic and architecturally significant buildings within the City of Peekskill. This year, 18 recipients will receive bronze plaques, which will be erected on their buildings and indicate the date of construction and the historic name of the structure. The Historic and Landmarks Preservation Board in cooperation with the Peekskill Museum selected the recipients for the 2002 Peekskill Historic Preservation Awards.
