

FUNDING FOR THE LINCOLN DEPOT AND LINCOLN PLAZA

Grants obtained by the City for Lincoln Depot restoration and Lincoln Plaza design and construction:

- \$1 million for the first phase of the Lincoln Depot restoration (State funds from the Governor's office and an EPF grant)
Status: Funds expended and Phase 1 complete.
- \$3 million Lincoln Depot Foundation funding available to complete the restoration of the depot and create museum.
- \$300,000 for the first phase of the Lincoln Plaza design and construction (State funds from an EPF grant)
- \$1.135 million to complete construction of the Lincoln Plaza (State funds from the Empire State Development Corporation).
- \$125,000 for design and fabrication of the Fireman's Memorial and the Bell Tower (State funds from the Community Projects Appropriation Fund)
Status: Project Complete and now located on Riverfront Green instead of Lincoln Plaza.
- \$1 million for the relocation and restoration of the Centennial Firehouse (State funds from the Empire State Development Corporation).
Status: Building collapsed in August 2008.
- \$350,000 for design and construction of a Visitors' Center (State funds from an EPF grant)
Status: Centennial Firehouse to be used for this purpose.
- \$950,000 for construction of a Pedestrian Walkway over the railroad tracks from the Lincoln Plaza to Riverfront Green (State funds from the Empire State Development Corporation)
Status: Will not be constructed on Depot site.
